#### 2023 Show Notes

Covid-19 gave us the unique opportunity to re-think our show format. Last year, our club tried a triple "Summer Solstice" show, which we intended to have on the last weekend of June. However, we ran into an ARBA "Grand Opening" party that weekend at their new facility in Pennsylvania. So we moved the show to the first weekend in July. That day was miserably hot and being 4<sup>th</sup> of July weekend, it was also expensive for travel and interfered when many club member's vacation and travel plans. We tried again this year, but found that ARBA was now having an "Anniversary Party" that last weekend in June. So back to the drawing board…

A bit of history: For many years, it had been very difficult to find judges for our traditional late April/Early May show date due to the large Ohio show as well as all of the national club shows held during this time period. In addition, the show secretary now has other obligations the first weekend in May as well as the first weekend in August (our traditional "Midnight Madness" show date.)

So this year, we had our Spring Show the first Sunday in June. That did not conflict with any regional shows. It was a double open and double youth show. Midnight Madness will be on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Saturday in August (August 19<sup>th</sup>). As in the past, it will be a late afternoon/evening show, and will also be a double open & double youth show. This show has traditionally only an open show. New for this year, we've added the youth sanctions as well, and moved the start time up to 4pm. Hopefully, we'll be done by Midnight!

#### Health Certificates

This is \*NOT\* a fair show, so health certificates (OCVI or Official Certificate Veterinary Inspection) are NOT required for entry into the ARBA sanctioned open and youth shows.

The Topsfield Fair Show on Saturday, September  $29^{th}$  will require OCVI certificates for all livestock show entries. That includes rabbits & cavies.

#### SHOW RULES

- 1. The show will be governed by the show rules and standard of perfection of the ARBA. Entry indicates acceptance of these rules and any other rule set by this club. The current ARBA show rules can be found on their website: www.arba.net.
- 2. JUDGING WILL START AT 4PM.
- 3. ABSOLUTELY NO PHONE ENTRIES. Entries with full payment must be postmarked by the closing date to be accepted, per ARBA show rule section 19. Entries not meeting this requirement will be returned. Be sure to include your telephone number with your entry in case we have questions. No Email entries. Please use our Website for electronic entry. Entries \$4 prior to entry deadline, 11:59pm Wednesday, August 16th. Late entries are \$5 each. Day of show entries \$6, and you must check in before 3pm for your entries to be accepted.
- 4. Make checks payable to the Essex County Rabbit and Cavy Breeders Association (ECR & CBA) and mail with entry to show secretary.
- 5. All entries must be paid to the secretary before judging starts. All un-shown entries will be billed by ECRCBA and future entries will not be accepted until past due accounts are paid. Checks that are returned will be subject to any fees that the bank assesses, handling charges and postage. After being notified by registered mail, the checks will be turned over to local police departments and the exhibitor will not be allowed to exhibit at future shows until account is paid. NO PAYBACKS, LEGS OR POINTS will be awarded until checks have cleared the bank.
- 6. All entries must be the bona fide property of the exhibitor(s) prior to entry. Each owner's personal name must be listed on the entry form.
- 7. The ECRCBA will not assume responsibility for loss of or injury to exhibitors' animals. All reasonable care will be used by the association in handling animals.
- 8. Sick or diseased animals shall not be brought into the showroom. The Show Superintendent has the right to examine any entry. Contagious animals will be removed from the showroom immediately, and entry fees forfeited.
- 9. Judging will be done in cages made for this purpose.
- 10. Do not ask for specific judges.
- 11. The judge's decisions will be final except in cases of absolute fraud. Protests must be filed with the show superintendent within 2 hours after judging and must be accompanied be a fee of \$25.00 which will be refunded if protest is sustained.
- 12. No one except the judge and his/her assistants are allowed behind the tables. Anyone interfering with the judging will have their entry eliminated without refund. Anyone wishing to assist a judge must write to the Superintendent and the Judge with whom they wish to work prior to the show.
- 13. This association reserves the right to appoint another judge or other judges in place of or in addition to those listed.
- 14. All rabbits are to be tattooed in the left ear with legible and permanent identification. All cavies must be tagged to be shown.
- 15. Ear# changes will be free for the first two changes. Each change thereafter will be \$1.00. Must be same sex and variety. Scratches are non-refundable.
- 16. NO COOP NUMBERS THIS SHOW! Please make sure your tattoos are legible!
- 17. A registrar will be available to register animals at the fairgrounds.
- 18. This is a CARRYING CASE SHOW. Carrying cages must have solid, leak-proof bottoms.
- 19. No open alcoholic beverages permitted in the building or on the fairgrounds.
- 20. Due to limited space in the building, please keep your carriers organized compactly and avoid using jumbo chairs inside. Leave aisles open for travel. There will be canopies set up out back, and you are welcome to bring your own canopies.
- 21. All grooming with blowers must occur outside. There are outlets at the back of the building for your blowers. Because food is served in the barn, grooming that causes fur to fly is not allowed inside. (A quick brush & fluff before showing is fine.)
- 22. No animals will be allowed in the dining area.
- 23. ARBA no longer requires comment cards to be filled out by the host club. Exhibitors will be expected to fill out their own comment cards. We will have a supply of comment cards available at the secretary's booth for exhibitors. Writers, at their discretion, may fill the cards out, but are not required to.
- 24. Youth exhibitors may enter sanctioned youth shows between the ages of five (5) and eighteen (18) years. An adult cannot show in youth classes at any time. Youth exhibitors are not required to carry their own animals to the table, however Youth entries must be carried and put onto judging tables by youth, not adults! Youth may show in either open or youth, but may not show the same animal in both during the same show (eg. Youth A and Open A is not allowed, but Youth A and Open B is allowed).
